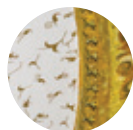

Admire architect Inigo Jones's amazing design of this 400-year-old royal villa



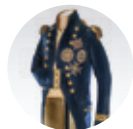

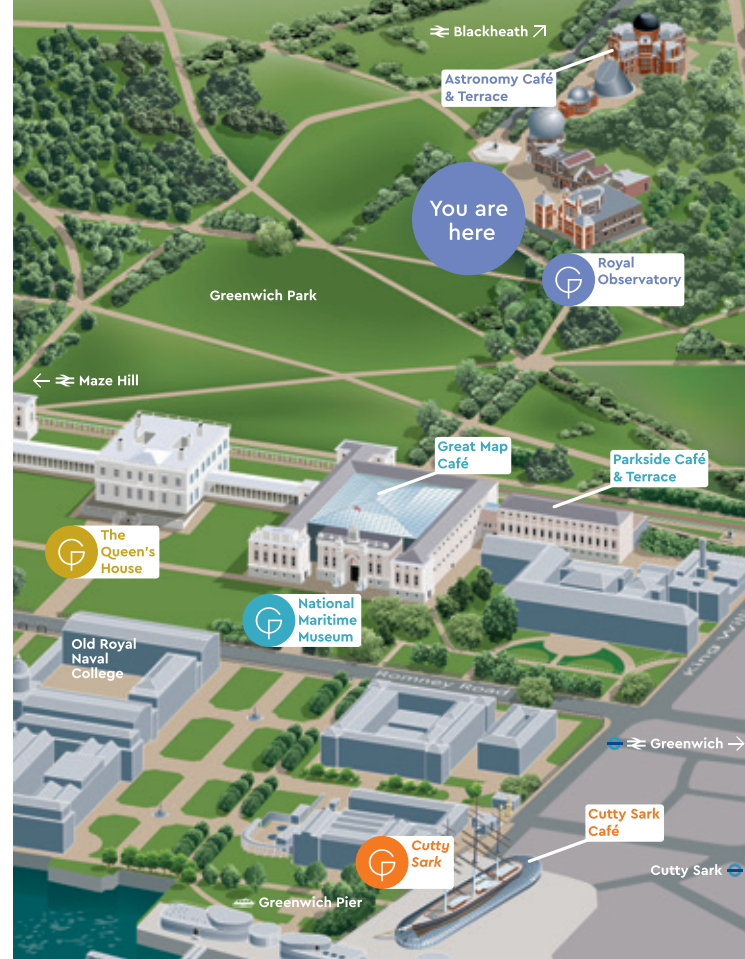

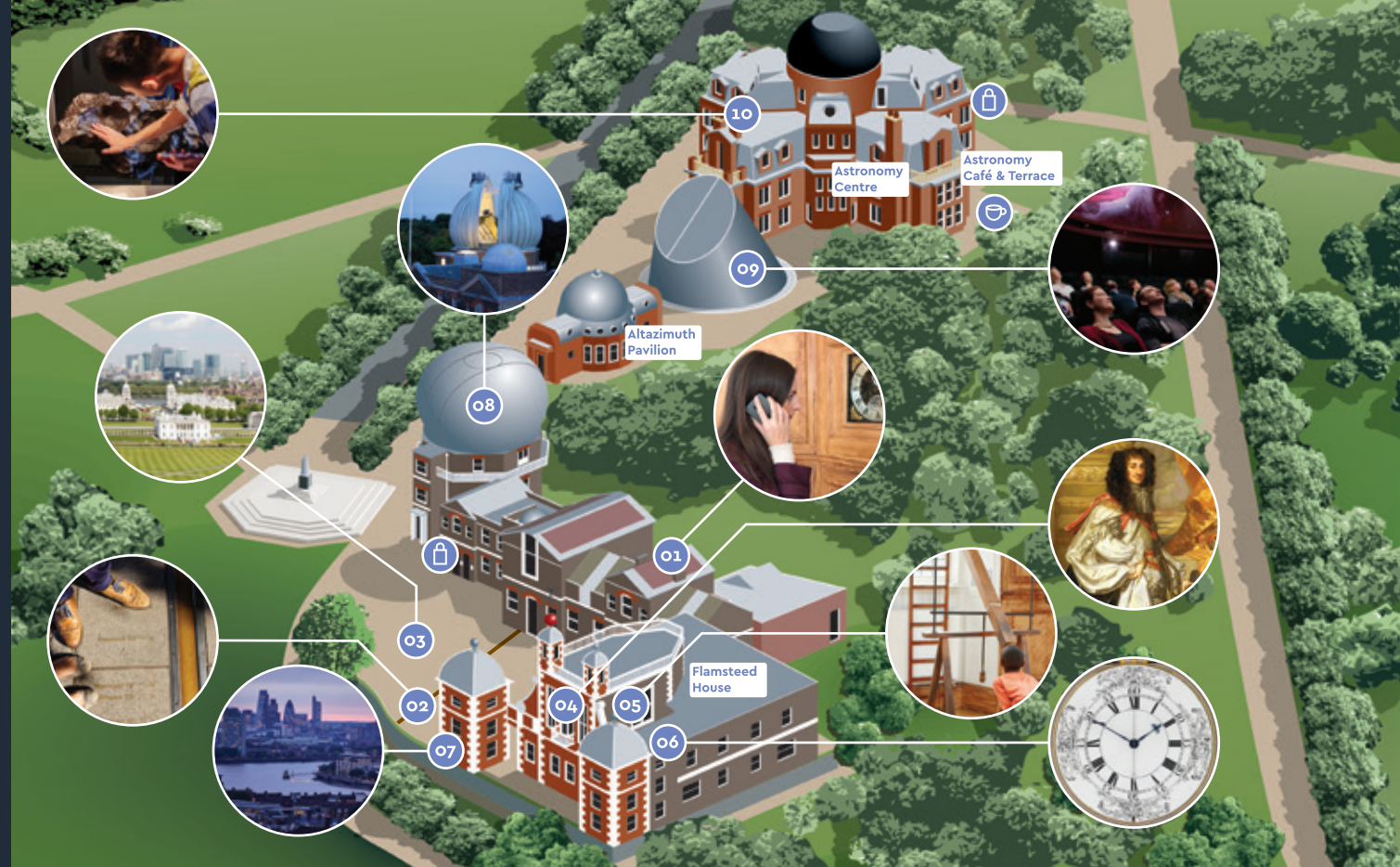
