

## Brownies Workshop - Star Room: Risk Assessment

### Severity of injuries scale (S)

- 1 - very minor/property
- 2 - minor/first aid
- 3 - medical attention
- 4 - hospitalisation
- 5 - death/irreparable damage

### Likelihood or risk scale (L)

- 1 - unlikely
- 2 - possible
- 3 - probable
- 4 - likely
- 5 - certain

### Risk Rating (S x L)

- 0-6 low risk
- 7-11 medium risk
- 12+ high risk

Activity/item	Hazard identified	Persons/property at risk	Control Measures	Severity	Likelihood	Risk Rating
Spotlight	Electrocution	Presenter	Check cables in good condition	3	1	3
	Burns	Presenter	Ensure the spotlight casing isn't touched until after the spotlight has cooled properly. Ensure no one else touches the spotlight at all.	2	1	2
Trips	Personal injury	Presenter & audience	Ensure all cables are placed out of the way, or in such a manner, to prevent trips	1	1	1
Scissors	Cuts	Presenter & audience	Scissors only to be used whilst students are sitting and when supervised by adult	2	1	2
Pins	Cuts	Presenter & audience	Only to be used whilst students are sitting and when supervised by adult	2	1	2
Slips from equipment on floor	Personal injury	Presenter & audience	Pick up all bits of card on floor. Ensure scissors, markers/pencils and glue are packed away after the session ends	2	1	2

Sun Observations	Blindness	Presenter & audience	Ensure presenter does not look directly at Sun. Repeat message repeatedly to students and ensure accompanying adults provide constant supervision	4	1	4
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
